Re: MSBA Vote: Parker Middle School Statement of Interest (SOI)

Below is the vote required by the Massachusetts School Building Authority to authorize the submission of a Statement of Interest by the April 29, 2022 deadline. I recommend the Select Board vote in the affirmative as follows:

Recommended/Required Vote:

Having convened in an open meeting on April 25, 2022, prior to the SOI submission closing date, the Select Board of the Town of Chelmsford, in accordance with its charter, by-laws, and ordinances, has voted to authorize the Superintendent to submit to the Massachusetts School Building Authority the Statement of Interest Form dated April 22, 2022 for the Parker Middle School located at 75 Graniteville Road which describes and explains the following deficiencies and the priority category(s) for which an application may be submitted to the Massachusetts School Building Authority in the future: Priority 2 – Elimination of existing severe overcrowding, Priority 4 – Prevention of severe overcrowding expected to result from increased enrollments, Priority 5 – Replacement, renovation or modernization of school facility systems, such as roofs, windows, boilers, heating and ventilation systems, to increase energy conservation and decrease energy related costs in a school facility, and Priority 7 – Replacement of or addition to obsolete buildings in order to provide for a full range of programs consistent with state and approved local requirements; and hereby further specifically acknowledges that by submitting this Statement of Interest Form, the Massachusetts School Building Authority in no way guarantees the acceptance or the approval of an application, the awarding of a grant or any other funding commitment from the Massachusetts School Building Authority, or commits the Town of Chelmsford to filing an application for funding with the Massachusetts School Building Authority.
