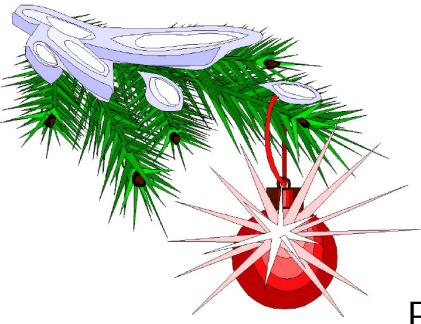
**Chelmsford Annual**
