The Town of Chelmsford, Massachusetts (the Owner) invites qualified bidders to bid on the following project: Chelmsford High School – Football Stadium Field -- Lighting Installation

**Scope of Work:** The scope of work is attached along with design specifications and relevant drawings.

**Bid Submittal:** Bids will be received at the Department of Public Works, 9 Alpha Road, Chelmsford Massachusetts 01824 up until 10:00 a.m. on June 1, 2022. All Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope and clearly marked “IFB – Chelmsford High School Football Stadium Field – Lighting Installation.”

**Site Visit:** An optional site visit will take place on: Monday, May 23rd at 1:00. All Bidders should meet at: Chelmsford High School Football Stadium Field at 200 Richardson Road.

**Site Conditions:** Each bidder shall be fully familiar with the existing conditions and limitations that may affect the execution of the work under this contract. The failure or omission of the bidder to receive or examine any form, addendum, or document or become acquainted with the conditions at the construction site shall in no respect relieve the bidder from any obligation contained in the contract or bid.

**Specifications:** All requirements in these specifications are at a minimum. Bidders shall comply with the full intent of these specifications and wherein they deviate from the specifications, bidder shall so state. These specifications are not intended to eliminate or restrict any reliable Contractor, but rather to protect the Owner from inadequate workmanship.

**Schedule:** Work shall begin upon execution of the Contract anticipated to be on or after June 20, 2022. Work to be completed by Friday, August 12, 2022. Note: anticipated delivery of the lights to the stadium is the end of the first week in July. MUSCO is targeting Friday July 8, 2022.

**Procedure:** This Invitation for Bid is issued in accordance with and subject to MGL c. 149 – Building Construction Contracts for projects between \$50,000 and \$150,000. The Town of Chelmsford reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the bid process.

**Contract Award:** The contract will be awarded to the most responsive and responsible bidder quoting the lowest price. Contract will be awarded within a week of Bid Opening.



## **INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

**Preparation and Submittal of Bid:** Bids are to be addressed to: Joyce Cote, DPW Business Manager; 9 Alpha Road, Chelmsford, MA and be labeled as follows: "Chelmsford High School Football Stadium Field – Lighting Installation." Bids will be accepted up to 10:00 a.m. on 6/1/22 at the DPW Facility located at 9 Alpha Road, Chelmsford, MA where they will be publicly opened and read.

Bids must be made in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders to be considered. The Contract will be awarded to the most responsive and responsible bidder offering the lowest price.

Bids shall be submitted on an unaltered BID SHEET (**attached**). Bids that are incomplete, conditional or obscure, or which contain any additions not called for shall be rejected. Where both written words and numerical figures are given, the written words shall apply in the event of conflict.

**Insurance Requirements:** Insurance Certificates: Successful bidder must provide the Town with a Certificate of Insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability, Combined Single Limit with a \$3,000,000 Annual Aggregate Limit. Automobile Liability of at least \$1,000,000 Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability per accident. Workers' Compensation as required by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The contractor shall indemnify and save harmless the Town, all of its officers, agents and employees from all suits, actions or claims of any character.

**Examination of Building Documents:** Each bidder shall examine the attached building documents in detail and base their bid on the amount of labor and materials required. Failure of any bidder to thoroughly examine the building documents and scope of work shall in no way relieve them of any obligation with respect to their bid.

Any corrections or changes to the Contract Documents will be issued as an Addendum to each plan holder and will become part of the Contract Documents. It is the responsibility of each bidder to

The Town of Chelmsford accepts no liability to provide accommodation to bidders who submit a response based upon information obtained from its website. Bidders may not alter (manually or electronically) the bid language or any bid documents. Unauthorized modifications to the body of the bid, specifications, terms or conditions, which change the intent of this bid are prohibited and will disqualify a response.

**Experience Requirements:** The bidder is required to submit a list of (3) references for similar projects.

**Qualifications of Bidder:** The Owner may make such investigations as he deems necessary to determine the ability of the bidder to perform the work, and the bidder shall furnish any requested information to the Owner for this purpose. The Owner reserves the right to reject any bid if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of such bidder fails to satisfy the Owner that such bidder is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract and to complete the proposed work.

**Bonds:** A bid bond of 5% payable to the Town of Chelmsford shall accompany each bid. This may be in the form of a certified check or bid bond. A Payment Bond equal to 50% of the contract will be required from the successful bidder.

**Prevailing Wages:** All bids shall include prevailing wage rates as set forth by the Department of Labor Standards (DLS). The prevailing wage rates schedule for this project is attached.

Questions regarding Prevailing Wage Rates shall be directed to Massachusetts Department of Labor Standards at (617) 626-6953.

The selected contractor is required to submit a copy of their payroll records to the Town of Chelmsford on a weekly basis. Payroll records are to be sent to the DPW Business Manager, 9 Alpha Road, Chelmsford, MA 01824.

**Bid Rejection / Cancellation:** The Town of Chelmsford known as the Owner, reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids and to waive any informality if deemed in the public's interest.

**Contract Award:** Failure of the Contractor to furnish Proof of Insurance or failure to comply with the conditions for entering into this agreement with the Owner within five (5) business days shall be just cause for cancelling the Award.

## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

### **Project Location:**

- Chelmsford High School Athletic Field; 200 Richardson Road, Chelmsford, MA

**Scope of Work:** General Scope, Detailed Specifications and Drawings are included in the Bid Package.

**Inspection:** The Superintendent of Schools, Jay Lang, or his designee, shall be the Owner's representative for the duration of the project. He will not be required to make continuous on-site inspections to check the quality or quantity of the work and he will not be responsible for the Contractor's failure to carry out the work in accordance with the Contract Documents. He may condemn work as failing to conform to the Contract Documents and shall have authority to stop work whenever such stoppage may be necessary in his reasonable opinion to insure the proper execution of the Contract.

In connection with the work, the Owner shall not be responsible for construction methods, means, techniques, sequences or procedures employed by the Contractor nor his safety programs, requirements, regulations or precautions.

**Correction of Work:** The Contractor shall promptly remove from the premises all work condemned by the Town as failing to conform to the Contract, whether incorporated or not, and the Contractor shall promptly replace and re-execute his own work in accordance with the Contract and without expense to the Owner and shall bear the expense of making good all work of other contractors destroyed or damaged by such removal or replacement.

**Extra Claims:** If the Contractor claims that any instructions, by drawings or otherwise, involve extra cost under the Contract, he shall contact the Superintendent of Schools promptly after the receipt of such instructions, prior to proceeding with the work, except in an emergency situation.

**Liens:** Neither the final payment nor any part of the retained percentage shall become due until the Contractor, if required, shall deliver to the Owner a complete release of all liens arising out of the Contract. The Contractor shall comply with all statutory provisions of the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts with regard to liens, Chapter 254 and 149 as amended.

**Record Keeping and Accounting Requirements:** The Contractor must make, and maintain for a least six years after final payment, books, records, and accounts which accurately and fairly reflect the contractor's transactions and dispositions; and comply with all Massachusetts regulations.

1. The Contractor shall provide all items, articles, materials, operations, tools, equipment, labor, and incidentals necessary and required to complete in an acceptable manner all work shown on the Drawings, and/or as specified herein, or both.
