

Dear Congresswoman Trahan:

The Town of Chelmsford, MA (Town) proposes the installation of new sidewalks on Parkerville Road between the town line with Westford and Maple Road. Parkerville Road is an arterial corridor in the town adjacent to the Byam Elementary School and currently has no pedestrian corridor for the community to access. This project will provide a new ADA compliant sidewalk on the north side of Parkerville Road for a length of 3,500 feet. The new sidewalk will meet ADA requirements and be constructed with granite curbing and asphalt sidewalk. Concrete transition panels and crosswalks will be installed across Garrison Road. The project will include adjacent property owner coordination for locating the new sidewalk corridor within the Town's existing right-of-way. The project will also include any necessary drainage adjustments, clearing and grading for the installation of the new sidewalk.

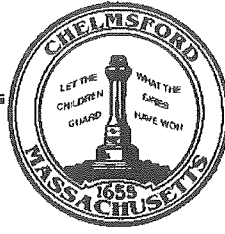
