Veterans out for Lunch. Lisa Devine reached out to McFarlin Manor to see if any of their community members would like to be taken out to lunch. Lisa Devine was referred to speak to a case manager which is still in process.

Pat Wojtas wanted to discuss the banners idea that the Parade Committee is interested in doing. The CMCC is currently not interested in supporting this endeavor.
